

Information for visiting drivers

Failure to comply will result in your vehicle not being attended to



Do

- Follow all instructions from authorised IGT staff
- Drive to the signed speed limits
- Follow established traffic routes
- Park in the designated areas
- Apply the hand brake before leaving the cab
- Position vehicle correctly on W/B to ensure accurate weighing
- Wear high visibility clothing & safety footwear
- Stay alert to all vehicle movements and use pedestrian walk ways at all times
- Ensure relevant paperwork is signed before tipping vehicle as directed
- Stand in a safe area away from all moving vehicles
- Stay visible at all times with the loading driver
- Report any dangerous occurrence

Do not

- Enter any grain store without authorisation from an IGT employee
- Bring children on to the port estate
- Reverse your vehicle without full all around vision or banksman
- Leave the ignition key in the ignition when not in the cab
- Stand in an area where you could be struck by another vehicle or falling load
- Leave the loading area without notifying the IGT loading driver
- Smoke
- Drive whilst using a hand held mobile phone
- Climb onto your lorry during loading
